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ELIGIBILITY

New Visions is open to artists working in all media. Artists must become a member of Pro Arts upon registration. PRO ARTS ENCOURAGES THE SUBMISSION OF NEW OR RECENT WORK that explores diverse genres and media.

RESTRICTIONS

Works weighing an excess of 50 pounds must be submitted on a rolling platform or with a handcart. Artwork must fit through the gallery front doors, no larger than 7'x 6'. All works must be professionally presented and ready for presentation. Multi-paneled pieces will be considered as separate pieces unless the work is hinged. PRO ARTS WILL NOT SUPPLY ANY TECHNOLOGY FOR THE EXHIBITION.

HOW TO SUBMIT WORK

PRE-REGISTER

Pre-register now at Pro Arts, online, by mail or in the gallery. Pre-registration closes Saturday, July 21 at 6pm. Basic registration is \$25 (not including membership) and includes up to two works; artists may submit up to 5 works for an additional fee. No refunds will be accepted.

SAME DAY REGISTRATION

Artists may also register at Pro Arts on July 25 from 12-7pm. Please note that all artists to be considered for the exhibition will be delivering artwork to the gallery on July 25 from 12-7pm. Same day registration is \$35 (not including membership) and includes up to two works; artists may submit up to 5 works for an additional fee. No refunds will be accepted.

ARTWORK DROP-OFF

Deliver artworks labeled with the included Pro Arts labels to Pro Arts at 550 Second Street, Oakland on Wednesday, July 25 between 12-7pm. All artists must be in line by 7pm. All works must be hand delivered to the gallery and be individually labeled. New Visions labels are included on the back of this form and are available on-line at www.proartsgallery.org. Artists are encouraged to submit a 50-word statement addressing the theme of the exhibition and its relationship to their work. Please attach statement with label to each work.

Conceptual performance, installation, sound installations, video and social practices must include a single page description accompanied by 2-3 images on a DVD or CD if applicable. All documentation must be submitted in a folder with each item properly labeled with artist's name, contact information and running length. Artists submitting multiple works in this genre must present each on an individual DVD or CD.

EARLY DROP-OFFS AND MAILED IN SUBMISSIONS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.

REVIEW AND SELECTION

If your work is selected for inclusion in the exhibition, you will be notified on Friday, July 26 by 6pm. IF YOU DO NOT RECEIVE NOTIFICATION BY TELEPHONE, YOU MUST PICK UP YOUR WORK ON SATURDAY, JULY 27, 12-6pm. All unselected works not claimed by Sunday, July 28 by 5pm are subject to a penalty of \$10 per day. Picture ID is required for pick-up.

LIABILITY

Entry in New Visions does not guarantee inclusion in the exhibition. Pro Arts, its employees and representatives are not responsible for any loss or damage resulting from handling prior to the exhibition or during installation, de-installation or the transportation of work.

RIGHTS AND CONDITIONS

Pro Arts reserves the right to photograph and reproduce chosen works for publicity and educational purposes. Participation in the exhibition shall be an agreement on the part of the artist to these conditions. Pro Arts reserves the right to exclude works submitted without appropriate preparation (documentation, mounting hardware, suitable frame/mat, etc.), or which are damaged or incomplete.

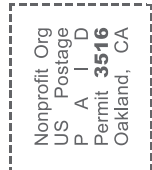
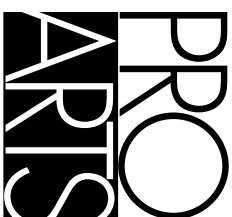
